



Membership FAQ's

Why is my membership changing?

Your membership is changing because the IHRIM Atlanta/SE Chapter will be a separate legal entity, IHRIM Atlanta/SE, on 4/1/2009. Membership in the IHRIM Association no longer includes membership in a local chapter as all local chapters will not exist after 3/31/2009.

How is my membership changing?

Since IHRIM Association and IHRIM Atlanta/SE are legally two separate organizations, you will need to join each organization separately.

As we transition to the new organization, active members as of 3/31/2009 will receive a free membership (\$20) in the Atlanta/SE Affiliate which will be good through 12/31/2009. As a member, the quarterly meeting fee is \$30.

What happens to my IHRIM National membership?

Your current IHRIM National membership will remain in force through the end date of your current registration and you can renew as you would normally.

Do I have to join both organizations?

No. You can join one or both organizations.

Membership FAQ's

What are the dues and fees for the Atlanta/SE Affiliate?

Annual dues are \$140 which includes a \$20 membership fee and \$30 for each of the 4 quarterly meetings. This can be paid annually or when you attend the quarterly meetings (the first meeting is \$50, the next 3 scheduled meetings are \$30 each). You can also pay the membership fee (\$20) and pay the meeting fees (\$30) for the meetings you attend until your annual membership expires.

Active IHRIM Association members as of 3/31/2009 will receive a free membership (\$20) for IHRIM Atlanta/SE which will be good through 12/31/2009

What are the meeting costs?

Member cost is \$30 per meeting, non-member is \$50. The \$30 meeting cost is included in paid annual memberships. You can purchase an annual membership (\$140) or pay as you go. In this case, the first meeting is \$50 and the next 3 scheduled meetings are \$30 each.

Is the \$50.00 for the first meeting that is attended per year?

Yes. Once you join and pay \$50, then the next 3 scheduled meetings are \$30.

What if I don't know if I will be able to go to any meetings but still want to be a member? Can I just pay \$20 now to become a member and then \$30 when I attend my first meeting?

Yes. Remember, the \$30 meeting fee is only valid until your annual membership expires.

What are the membership classifications?

Regular Members: A professional whose employment and primary career interest is in the field of human resources, human resource information management or information technology. Faculty members of colleges and universities who hold assistant, associate, or full professor rank in human resource management, management, management information systems or any of its specializations will qualify for Regular membership. Regular Members enjoy all benefits, rights and privileges of Chapter membership including the right to vote in matters of Chapter business and hold elective office in the Chapter

Affiliate Members: A professional engaged in providing a product and/or service to the corporate HR or IT community. Affiliate Members enjoy all benefits, rights and privileges of Chapter membership including the right to vote in matters of Chapter business and hold elective office in the Chapter..

Honorary Members: The Executive Committee may grant Honorary membership to retired Chapter Members, Outside Directors and others who do not otherwise qualify for membership. Honorary Members enjoy all benefits, rights and privileges of Chapter membership including the right to vote in matters of Chapter business and hold elective office in the Chapter.
